


PharmAcademic Home Page

The PharmAcademic **Home** page provides users access to information from all the colleges of pharmacies and residency programs associated with the user. The top half of the home page unifies information from all sites for the user; the bottom half is site-specific (limited to the site selected by the user at login).

The **Global Task List** displays all assessments that require completion/cosign by the user for all sites associated with the user. As always, the list can be filtered to include cosign requests and assessments can be accessed by clicking on the name of the assessment.

The **My Schedule** tab displays the user's schedule inclusive of all the user's sites. The user can click on the course/rotation to access information about the student (including a link to the student's portfolio), site, preceptor, and information associated with the course/rotation (including artifacts of learning entered by the student.)

- **Courses** (available courses)
- **Faculty and Staff** (college of pharmacy faculty and staff – not available to students)

Administrative Links are available to faculty/staff at the college of pharmacy (not preceptors or students) to manage the program. The user's role determines which buttons are available.
